### Watkins Glen Items

1. The Watkins Glen track is rented on Wednesday until 5:00 PM. We will be unable to begin parking procedures until the track goes cold for the day. Trucks should stage in the large field across from Registration at the top of the hill. Registration will open between 3:00 PM – 6:00 PM on Wednesday in order to get everyone signed in. **Watkins Glen is an ISC track and they require ALL participants to sign the WGI waiver and receive a sticker including ALL Hard Card holders.** Please make sure your crew and all of your guests are aware of this requirement.
2. We will be in a **paved paddock** for this event and not in the garages this year. A paddock map is attached for your reference.
3. Gasoline sales at this event must be paid for with cash or check. No Credit Cards will be accepted.
4. Golf carts that remain in the paddock area do not need a sticker. If, however, you plan to take your golf cart or ATV outside the confines of the paddock you will need to apply for a sticker with Shirley Stocum [sstocum@theglen.com](mailto:sstocum@theglen.com) and furnish her with a copy of your insurance for the vehicle.

### Canadian Border Crossing

5. Reminder to all teams to renew, or apply for your SCAC code for crossing the border into Canada. The process is easier this year and paperwork can be completed and processed up to two weeks before our event at Mosport.
