RE: WCPB # 4-2007 – 2007 Credential Information

As noted on page two of the 2007 World Challenge Info packet there will be some changes to the Credential System this year. The changes are listed below;

- Six (6) free credentials will accompany each entry. Each entry may purchase up to a maximum of 11 passes, or hard cards, from SCCA Pro Racing.
- Hot Pit passes will cost \$75 each and will include the \$35 temporary SCCA membership
- Paddock Guest passes will cost \$25
- Team members attending **three (3)** or more events **must** purchase a **hard card**. If a team member leaves the team his/her hard card must be surrendered to SCCA Pro Racing in order to re-use that spot on the team roster.
- Team members 16-18 years of age may apply for a hard card providing a minor waiver signed by both parents is on file with the SCCA Pro Racing office. These hard cards are only handled by the SCCA office in Topeka and are not available at event registration.
- Replacement cost of lost credentials is \$100
- Special handling fee of \$50 shall be assessed if a credential application arrives less than two (2) weeks prior to the date needed.
- Each team must have a credit card on file, or an open check must be left at registration, to cover the cost of credential fees incurred on any given weekend. A complete accounting of registration fees will be available after each race.
- A Designated Team Representative (DTR) must be identified to the Registrar. He, or she, will be the **only** person authorized to make additions, or deletions, to the list. It would be helpful for the DTR to leave a cell number in case unexpected guests arrive at registration.
- As in the past we will try to help you out with hometown races. Each driver, or team, must designate his/her home town race. The driver, or team, will receive 10 extra passes for one (1) race per season at a cost of \$10/per credential.
