Beginning with Mosport and at any event with a good line of sight from the pit lane to Timing & Scoring, SCCA Pro Racing will provide World Challenge teams a wireless network to receive Timing & Scoring Data with the AMB RMonitor Program.

To read the data on the network, please download the AMB RMonitor program software at:

Unzip the file you download and then run the RMonitor\_setup.exe file to install the program.

After installing the RMon software you will need to set up the connection and your page views.

## Set Up Connection

Select **Settings > Communication**

- Click TCP/IP
- Set IP Address to: 192.168.1.106
- Set Port Number to: 40000
- Select "OK"

## Set Up Windows

For Practice and Qualifying, go to **File > New Result Window > Practice Results**

- Select the check boxes for the Columns you would like to display
- Traditionally, this will be: Pos, Marker, Car, Last Name, Laps, Last Lap Time, Best Lap, Best Lap Time and Different. However, users may choose whatever they like.
- Select "OK"
- When the result window opens, you can move columns by clicking on the header and sliding them left or right. You can also change the font face and size under "Layout".

For Races, you will need to open a window that sorts by laps complete and not fast lap time (as with the Practice Screen). Go to **File > New Result Window > Current Race Results**.

- Select the check boxes for the Columns you would like to display
- Select "OK"
- When the result window opens, you can move columns by clicking on the header and sliding them left or right. You can also change the font face and size under "Layout".

In order to receive data, you will need to connect to the following network:

SSID (Name): WORLDCHALLENGE

At this point, there is no password. However, one may be added at a later date and that information will be distributed.

Note: you may have to close and reopen RMON after changing the communications settings.
