PADDOCK AND PARKING INFORMATION:

Paddock will open for SPEED World Challenge participants Thursday April 6, 2006 at 8:00 AM. Prior to paddock opening teams may stage their transporters in the South Shore Launch Ramp, 590 Queensway Drive, Long Beach.

Team passenger cars will be limited to one automobile per race car participant and will be parked in the Arena Parking Structure. Vehicles requiring access to the Arena Parking Structure must be in the garage **by 7:00 a.m.** each race day morning. Oversize vehicles will not be allowed in the Arena Parking Structure. Parking passes will be distributed to Speed World Challenge GT Series teams by the Speed World Challenge Series credential office.

LOCAL REGULATIONS:

- No off-roading
- No illegal substances
- No firearms or weapons
- Speed Limits:
Paddock Area – 5 mph
- No glass containers
- All trash must be placed in the provided receptacles
- No stakes may be driven into the asphalt
- Used oil and coolant must be placed in the marked containers in the paddock area
- All tires, fuel drums and other used automotive accessories must be removed by their respective teams. Grand Prix Association of Long Beach, LLC will charge the Sanctioning Body for the cost of disposing any items left on the property. The Sanctioning Body will charge these costs to the teams.
- No smoking in the pit lane
- **No one under the age of 18 is permitted in the pit lane**
- Camping is with permit only and is acceptable only in designated areas
