**DIRECTIONS TO TRACK:**

Mid-Ohio Sports Car Course is conveniently located in Lexington, Ohio, 60 miles north of Columbus and 75 miles south of Cleveland

From Columbus: Take I-71 north to State Route 95 east. Follow State Route 95 for two miles and go north on State Route 314 for 15 miles. Turn right on Steam Corners Road. Mid-Ohio is one mile on the left.

From Cleveland: Take I-71 south to U.S. 30. Go west on U.S. 30 to State Route 314 south. Follow State Route 314 for seven miles and turn left on Steam Corners Road. Mid-Ohio is one mile on the left.

**PADDOCKING AND PARKING INFORMATION:**

Paddock will open to World Challenge teams Wednesday May 17, 2006 at 10:00am and close at 5:00 p.m. Paddock will re-open Thursday May 18, 2006 at 7:00 a.m.

**PROMOTER TEST DAY:**

There will be a NON-SCCA PRO sanctioned; Promoter Organized Test Day May 18 from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Advance arrangements can be made through Mid-Ohio Sports Car Course. Teams participating in the test day are responsible to confirm times with the promoter. **Teams can pre-register by May 15, for a discounted fee of \$350. Teams registering after May 15, or the day of the test will pay \$450. Motorcoach spaces will be \$500 (Paddock) and \$100 (grass overflow) Space size will be 22 feet wide for grass area. The awning fee is \$2,500 (required for any provision of food service not contracted through the promoter)

Electric Hookup in the Paddock is \$250. Competitor Camping in the Paddock is restricted to self-contained motor homes and is subject to a fee. These passes can be purchased at gate 3 security headquarters.

**GOLF CART RENTAL:**

Payment in full is due at time of reservation. **Personal/team golf cart use requires the purchase of a \$100 vehicle pass.** Golf Cart pass is sold by the Mid-Ohio Sports Car Course and is available at the main office. Golf carts must be operated by licensed drivers.

**DISPOSAL AND RECYCLING:**

Trash receptacles and Safety-Kleen disposal/recycling stations are located throughout the Mid-Ohio Sports Car Course paddock compound(s). Each of the containers is labeled to indicate their intended use. Please dispose of your waste responsibly. Do not pour oil, gas, coolant or any other automotive fluid on the ground.

**FUEL:**

Sunoco, the spec fuel of SPEED World Challenge, will be available at the track.

Please check local and state laws before transporting fuel to or from the facility.

Fuel containers of any size, whether full or empty, may not be discarded at the facility. You will be billed for any such containers at the rate charged to Mid-Ohio plus 50%.

**LOCAL REGULATIONS:**

**CAMPING:** Motor home camping is restricted to self contained motor homes (running water with holding tank) and is permitted only in designated areas. Spaces are limited to 25 feet wide. Camping is subject to a fee. Passes can be purchased at the gate 3 security headquarters. Spectator tent camping is permitted in the Johnsonville campground area and the rules for the campground will be strictly enforced

No Firearms are permitted on Mid-Ohio Property. Mid-Ohio is not CCW complaint.

No Fireworks are permitted on Mid-Ohio property.

**RENTAL EQUIPMENT, CHAIRS, TABLES:** Deliveries of rental equipment (i.e. forklifts, golf carts, etc.) by non-approved Mid-Ohio Sports Car Course vendors is not be allowed. Richland Glass and Tool (419) 884-3908 is the closest approved rental equipment supplier.

**VENDING:** Vendor sales, tent rentals, souvenirs, program sales are handled by Mary Wier (614) 793-4613.

**PETS:** No pets are allowed at the Mid-Ohio Sports Car Course facility.

**SPEED LIMIT:** Speed limit in all spectator areas is 20 mph.

**BIKES/SCOOTERS:** Tow vehicles, ATV's, mopeds, etc. are not allowed out of the paddock or false grid areas. Licensed mopeds may leave the paddock areas but then need to purchase a vehicle pass. Bikes are not allowed anywhere on the Mid Ohio property.

**PASSENGER VEHICLE/MOTORHOME PARKING:** Parking: Only team transporters and associated vehicles will be permitted to park in the competitor transport areas of the paddocks. All other vehicles will be required to use general parking areas. Traffic and fire lanes must be kept open. Parking rules/signs will be strictly enforced in the paddocks and throughout the Mid-Ohio Sports Car Course. Vehicles parked illegally will be towed. Motorized vehicles are not allowed on the spectator amphitheater mounds. Do not block the view of other spectators. All platforms must be permanently mounted on truck beds, not more than six feet high, and incapable of being elevated.

## MID-OHIO SPORTS CAR COURSE FACILITY RULES

Mid-Ohio Sports Car Course opens at 7:00 a.m. each event day. All spectators must be off the premises by 7:00 p.m. Sunday evening.

**Personal golf carts** (those not rented from Golf Car and Equipment) require a \$100.00 vehicle pass, purchased separately for each event, which must be displayed at all times. All golf carts must be operated by a licensed driver. No golf carts may be driven on spectator mounds.

Spectator **bicycles are not permitted** anywhere on Mid-Ohio property.

No spectator personal "off road" vehicles, dirt bikes, ATVs, mopeds, minibikes, scooters, etc., are permitted on Mid-Ohio property.

To preserve Mid-Ohio's family atmosphere, profanity and drunkenness will not be tolerated. If you are bothered by your neighbor at the camping area or by another spectator, please report him/her to Guest Services personnel. Guest Services is located at the Gate 3 entrance.

**No pets** on any kind are permitted at Mid-Ohio Sports Car Course.

**No firearms** are permitted on Mid-Ohio property. Mid-Ohio is not CCW compliant.

**No fireworks** are permitted on Mid-Ohio property.

In the interest of safety, Mid-Ohio **reserves the right to inspect** all personal property, including vehicles, backpacks and coolers.

All photographic, video and digital images taken during any track event, including those featuring spectators, whether made or purchased by Mid-Ohio Sports Car Course or its affiliates, are property of Mid-Ohio Sports Car Course and may be used in advertising and promotional materials at its sole discretion.

The **North Gate is an advance ticket entrance only**. To purchase tickets, use the Main Gate entrance off Steam Corners Road.

Follow the signs and instructions of the parking marshals.

All spectator, pedestrian and mound areas may not be reserved by roping them off or covering them with tarps overnight unless authorized by Mid-Ohio Sports Car Course. Any tarps, etc., left overnight will be collected by Mid-Ohio staff. These items can be picked up at Guest Services located at Gate 3.

Motorized vehicles are not allowed on the spectator amphitheater mounds.

Do not block the view of other spectators. Scaffolding is prohibited. All platforms must be permanently mounted on truck beds, not more than six feet high, and incapable of being elevated.

Corner workers are trained to deal with on-track emergencies. Therefore, under no circumstances are spectators permitted to cross fences or go on course at any time.

The **speed limit is 20 mph** in all areas of the track.

Climbing and sitting in trees, or using trash barrels as viewing platforms, are not permitted. No tents may be tied down to spectator fences. No tents, canopies or dining flies may be erected on amphitheater viewing mounds. Sitting and standing on gates is not permitted.

There are **no Refunds or exchanges** on any ticket sales.

**Failure to abide by these rules may result in a nonrefundable expulsion from the premises.**

**Mid-Ohio Sports Car Course is not responsible for damage to personal property while on our premises.**

To: Parent and/or Legal Guardian of minor participant:

Enclosed please find the *Waiver and Release of Liability and Indemnity Agreement* to be filled out and returned to TrueSports, Inc. dba Mid-Ohio Sports Car Course. This Agreement must be **filled out completely, signed by both parents and notarized** prior to the participation of a minor at Mid-Ohio Sports Car Course. This waiver must be received (10) ten days prior to the event in order for the minor to participate; this covers only the event and dates stated on the waiver. \_\_\_\_\_. **A copy of a valid birth certificate and/or drivers' license must accompany the signed, notarized waiver** verifying the minor participant is at least 15 (fifteen) years of age.

It is understood that in order for a minor participant to compete that a parent must accompany said minor to Mid-Ohio Sports Car Course and be present throughout the duration of the event before participation is allowed. **If a parent is unable to accompany said minor a Legal Guardian must be in attendance with a current letter notarized by both parents** granting the legal guardian the right to represent the parents of said minor and/or seek medical care. The letter must be brought to the Mid-Ohio Call Center and given to myself (Brenda Weber) before the said minor may compete.

The minor's given name must be on the waiver. If the fully executed waiver and specified additional documents (birth certificate and/or drivers' license) are not received prior to the event, the minor will not be allowed to participate in the event. Faxed copies will not be accepted, **nor can the waiver be turned in at the event.**

**TRUESPORTS, INC./THE MID-OHIO SPORTS CAR COURSE  
WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT

IN CONSIDERATION for allowing the minor to participate in any way in the event or activity encompassed by this Agreement and/or permitting the minor, parent and/or guardian to enter for any purpose any "restricted area" (herein defined as including, but not limited to, the racing surface, pit areas, infield, burn out area, approach area, shut down area, and all walkways and concessions and other appurtenant areas where any activity related to the event occurs or where admittance to the general public is restricted) the parent and/or guardian ON BEHALF OF THE MINOR AS WELL AS ON BEHALF OF THEMSELVES agree as follows:

1. THE PARENT AND/OR GUARDIAN will immediately inspect the restricted area upon entering it and warrant that their entry therein and/or the minor's event participation constitutes an acknowledgment that they have inspected the restricted area and find it safe and reasonably suited for the purpose of its use. The undersigned agree that if at any time in the restricted area they believe something is unsafe, such unsafe condition will be brought to the attention of an official and the parent and/or guardian will remove themselves and the minor from the restricted area and preclude the minor from further participation in the event or activity. If the parent and/or guardian did not actually inspect the restricted area, then they acknowledge that they had the right and opportunity to do so (but knowingly waived that right) and warrant that their entry therein and/or the minor's event participation constitutes an acknowledgment that the restricted area is safe and reasonably suited for the purpose of its use.

2. THE PARENT AND/OR GUARDIAN (ON BEHALF OF THEMSELVES AND THE MINOR) HEREBY ASSUME FULL RESPONSIBILITY FOR AND RISK OF BODILY INJURY, DEATH OR PROPERTY DAMAGE due to the negligence of the "releasees" (as identified below) or otherwise, while in or upon the restricted area for any purpose including competing, officiating, observing, working or participating in the event or activity. **The undersigned recognize and understand that there are inherent risks and dangers associated with participation in the event and admission within the restricted area that could cause severe bodily injury, disability, and death.** Further, such risks and dangers may be caused by the negligent actions or negligent failure to act of the releasees and others. All of the risks and dangers associated with participating in the event and entry into restricted areas may not be foreseeable at this time and they are assumed notwithstanding.

3. THE PARENT AND/OR GUARDIAN ON BEHALF OF THEMSELVES AS WELL AS ON BEHALF OF THE MINOR release, discharge, and covenant not to sue and waive all claims against TrueSports, Inc., its affiliates (including, without limitation, The Mid-Ohio Sports Car Course and The Mid-Ohio School), other promoters, participants, track operators, track owner or landowner, officials, car owners, drivers, pit crews, all persons in the restricted area, sponsors, advertisers, lessees and lessors of the premises used to conduct the event and their respective owners, directors, officers, agents, and employees (collectively referred to as "releasees") from any and all liabilities, claims, demands, losses, damages and/or expenses on account of any injury (including, but not limited to, the death) of the parent, guardian or minor or damage to property, caused or alleged to be caused in whole or in part by the negligence of the releasees or otherwise.

4. THE PARENT AND/OR GUARDIAN ON BEHALF OF THEMSELVES AS WELL AS ON BEHALF OF THE MINOR hereby agrees to indemnify and save and hold harmless the releasees and each of them from any and all liabilities, claims, demands, losses, damages and/or expenses on account of any injury (including, but not limited to, the death) of the parent, guardian or minor or damage to property, caused or alleged to be caused in whole or in part by the negligence of the releasees or otherwise.

**THE PARENT/GUARDIAN HAS READ AND SIGNS THE WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT AND DOES SO VOLUNTARILY AND WITH THE UNDERSTANDING THAT SUBSTANTIAL RIGHTS ARE BEING GIVEN UP. FURTHER, THE PARENT/GUARDIAN RECOGNIZES AND AGREES THAT THEY ARE EXECUTING THIS AGREEMENT ON BEHALF OF THEMSELVES, ON BEHALF OF THE MINOR AND ON BEHALF OF THEIR AND THE MINOR'S RESPECTIVE PERSONAL REPRESENTATIVES, EXECUTORS, AND HEIRS.**
