Take 401 east to exit 431 in Bowmanville (Waverley Rd/Durham 57).
Go north on Durham 57 to Region Rd. 20.
Go east on Region Rd. 20 to Concession Rd. #10
Turn onto Concession Rd. #10 and follow road to desired entrance or Registration Centre.

- Speed limit is 10 km in the Paddock.
- No Camping.
- Stay ON established roads and OFF the sand hills.
- Keep all vehicles off the race track.

- Do listen to track marshals and security staff. They are there for everyone's well-being and safety.

- Off-road vehicles permitted only in the paddock and only for race-related business by licensed drivers aged 16 years or older.

- Speed limit is 15 km in camping areas,
