There is a \$50 fee for shipments that need to be unloaded by Road America personnel using Road America equipment.

LOCAL REGULATIONS:

- Any motorized paddock vehicle (team golf cars, 4-wheelers, scooters etc.) requires an event-specific paddock access sticker that is available at registration.
- All persons driving motorized vehicles in the paddock must be licensed drivers and have their driver's license available for inspection at all times.
- No 4-wheelers, scooters or non-licensed vehicles are allowed outside of the paddock area.
- No roller blades, roller skates, skateboards, non-motorized scooters or bicycles are allowed in the paddock or in any area of the Road America facility.
