**MEDIA CENTER:**

The Time Warner Media Center is centrally located in the infield between the NASCAR NEXTEL Cup Series and NASCAR Busch Series garages. The Press Box, offering full-view of the Speedway, is located above the start/finish line on VIP Luxury Suite level of the General Motors grandstand.

Directions:

**From the East:**

- Take Hwy 64 to Asheboro, then take Hwy 49 South to Harrisburg. Follow the signs from Harrisburg to the speedway. Turn right on Morehead Road.
- Take Hwy 73 from Albemarle to Hwy 49. Take Hwy 49 South to Harrisburg. Turn right on Morehead Road. (at Circle K store).

**From the North/Northeast:**

- Take I-85 South to Exit 58 (Hwy 29 & 601). Take Hwy 29 South to the speedway.
- Take I-85 South to Exit 55 (Hwy 73). Take Hwy 73 East to Hwy 29. Take Hwy 29 South to the speedway.
- Take I-85 South to Exit 52 (Poplar Tent Road). Turn left on Poplar Tent Road and follow the signs to the speedway.
- Take I-77 South to Exit 25 (Hwy 73). Take Hwy 73 East to Hwy 29 South to the speedway.

**From the West/Southwest:**

- Take I-85 North to Exit 42 (Hwy's 29 & 49). Take Hwy 49 North to Harrisburg.
- Follow the signs to the speedway.
- Take I-85 to Exit 42 (Hwy's 29 & 49). Take Hwy 29 North to the speedway.
- Take I-85 North to Exit 48 (I-485). Take I-485 to Hwy 29. Take Hwy 29 North to the speedway.

**From the Southeast:**

- Take Hwy 601 North to Hwy 29. Take Hwy 29 South to the speedway or I-485.
- Take I-485 to Hwy 49 North to Harrisburg. left on Morehead Road.
- Take I-485 to Hwy 29 North to speedway.

**PADDOCK AND PARKING INFORMATION:**

Paddock will open for SPEED World Challenge participants Wednesday, May 23, 2007 at 9:00 AM. Prior to paddock opening teams may stage their transporters in the hauler staging lot accessible from Entrance P off of Morehead Road (look for signs).

Team passenger cars will be limited to one automobile per race car participant and will be parked in the lot outside of the Underpass located at Gate 26 (golf car shuttles provided). Parking passes will be distributed to Speed World Challenge GT Series teams by the Speed World Challenge Series credential office.

ALL SCCA official and team haulers and vehicles must vacate infield on Thursday night immediately following event.

**REGISTRATION:** The Credential Office is located at Entrance P off of Morehead Road. Look for signs designating the SCCA registration area. See event schedule for times.

Registration will close at designated times no exceptions.

Please make sure that all guests, sponsors and team members are aware of registration hours. After registration is closed the racetrack controls access to the facility and a ticket must be purchased to gain access. Once a ticket has been purchased there are NO REFUNDS.

Items That Are Prohibited Inside Gate Area:

- No umbrellas of any kind
- No glass bottles
- No strollers (inside grandstand area)
- No bags/Backpacks over 14 x 14 x 14
- No coolers over 14" x 14"
- No pets (unless they are service animals helping guests with disabilities)
- No weapons, including, but not limited to, firearms, knives, and impact weapons
- No skateboards, roller skates, or scooters
- No bicycles, golf carts, mopeds, etc. ADA-compliant one person
- No beach balls, balloons, etc.
- No signs or banners
- No horns, whistles, or other loud items

Lowe's Motor Speedway will not be responsible for items left in the speedway or around gate areas!

**Questions on Race day****1) Where do I purchase tickets for the race?**

Answer: You can purchase your tickets through the Main Ticket Office at **1-800-455-FANS** which is located on the 2nd floor of our main offices. On race days, there are ticket offices open at every gate.

**2) After I have purchased my tickets, when and where can I pick them up?**

Answer: If you have purchased tickets in advance, but did not have them mailed, you may pick them up at the Will Call window. Up until race week, the Will Call window is located in the Main Ticket Office on the 2nd Floor of Smith Tower. During the week of the event, the Will Call window moves to Gate 4. (Hours are 8-6 except the day of event.)

**3) Where is the best place to park at the Speedway?**

Answer: There is free parking surrounding the entire Speedway for your convenience. Check the online maps to find the free parking area closest to your seats and/or your traveling point. Driving directions, [click here](#).

**Handicapped Parking:**

We also have several reserved handicap spots located outside the Speedway. These parking spaces may be purchased through the Lowe's Motor Speedway ticket office at **1-800-455-FANS**.

Unreserved handicap spots are available in the VIP parking lots in the front and back sides of the track. These spots operate on a first-come, first-served basis and require a proper hangtag or license plate along with official identification. Refer to the map for specific areas.

**Notes:**

Speedway officials urge race fans to arrive at the track early. Use the extra time to tailgate, visit displays, souvenir row and enjoy pre-race activities. If possible, plan your trip to arrive a couple hours before the race is scheduled to begin.

Turn to WSOC-FM 103.7 for up-to-the-minute traffic reports.

I-85 to Exit 49 (Speedway Blvd.) is usually the most congested road on event days. Good alternates are Hwy 29 from both the North and the South and Hwy 49 to Morehead Road.

**4) How do I get to the souvenirs and hospitality sections?**

Answer: Souvenir stands are located all around the Speedway, and we also have a Souvenir Village located at the corner of Highway 29 and Speedway Boulevard. Our Hospitality Village is located just outside of Gates 6, 7, and 8 on the front side of the track.

**5) Where are the nearest ATM's located?**

Answer: There are several ATM's located throughout the facility. Check your fan guide when you arrive at the Speedway for locations.

**6) Can I bring a cooler to the race?**

If so, can I bring alcoholic beverages into the Speedway? Answer: Yes. Your cooler can be no larger than 14 x 14 x 14, soft and hard coolers acceptable. This also includes soft-sided, collapsible coolers. You may also bring alcoholic beverages into the Speedway in CANS ONLY. No glass bottles are allowed. No food or drink is allowed up to Speedway Club and Suite levels.

**7) What types of foods are available at the Speedway's concession stands?**

Answer: A variety of foods such as nachos, hamburgers, and hot dogs can be found at concession stands located around the Speedway. There are also a number of independent vendors including pizza, barbeque, etc.

**8) Is drive-up camping available?**

Answer: Yes. All camping on LMS property is reserved, but race weeks operates on a first-come, first-served basis. Each camping area is staffed with 24 hour security and is either located near a shower house or has daily shuttles running daily to our restroom/shower facilities.

**9) How do I contact someone at the race in the event of an emergency?**

Answer: In the event of an EMERGENCY, locate the nearest LMS security representative or customer service representative to assist you. They are located throughout the facility and will gladly help you with this situation. **Call 704-455-7911.**

**10) What are the best ways to reach the Speedway before the race and get home after the race?**

Answer: The North Carolina State Highway Patrol, along with the North Carolina Department of Transportation, work hard to expedite traffic both in and out of the Speedway. Their primary goal is to get you to the Speedway before the race and to a major road as soon as possible. Please note that the Department of Transportation will counterflow traffic on roads surrounding the Speedway for faster and more efficient traffic flow both in and out. [Driving Directions](#).

- All tires, fuel drums and other used automotive accessories must be removed by their respective teams. Lowe's Motor Speedway will charge the Sanctioning Body for the cost of disposing any items left on the property. The Sanctioning Body will charge these costs to the teams.
- No smoking in the pit lane
- **No one under the age of 18 is permitted in the pit lane**
- Camping is with permit only and is acceptable only in designated areas
