PADDOCKING AND PARKING INFORMATION:

The paddock will open for SCCA Speed World Challenge competitors on Thursday, May 24th from 9:00 am to 6:00 pm.

All teams must check in with Lime Rock Park Registration and Security prior to entering paddock. All oversized vehicles (semi-truck, large RV/trailer combos etc.) will park in Registration Parking and await clearance and an escort to the paddock. Vehicles under 10,000 lbs. may proceed to their respective spaces in the paddock. Any vehicles over this weight will be considered "oversized" and must follow the paddock parking procedure for oversize vehicles.

Oversize vehicles may exit the paddock only when all on-track activity has ceased and the track has been declared a "cold track."

Oversize vehicles may exit the paddock only after receiving clearance from Lime Rock Park EMS and Guest Services.

Only team transporters and associated vehicles will be permitted to park in the team transporter areas of the paddocks, under the direction of Lime Rock Park. All other vehicles will be required to use general parking areas. Traffic and fire lanes must be kept open. Parking rules/signs will be strictly enforced in the paddocks and throughout Lime Rock Park. Vehicles parked illegally will be towed.

There will be **limited parking** in the paddock area. Each team will receive **one** car pass. Overflow parking for all competitors will be in the general parking areas.

SHIPMENTS:

DISPOSAL AND RECYCLING:

Waste fluid reclamation stations are located in both A and B paddocks. Separate receptacles are labeled with regard to their contents (oil, antifreeze, fuel, etc.) please deposit accordingly: Blue steel tank; used motor oil, Brown drums; engine coolant, Black drums; brake fluid, parts cleaner, soiled fuel, etc. Large requirements for waste fluid recycling should contact Lime Rock Park staff for direction.

Please dispose of waste responsibly. Do not pour oil, gas coolant or any other automotive fluid on the ground.

- No children under 18 allowed in paddock without adult supervision

Quiet Hours:

Lime Rock is subject to local ordinances, which limit the times during which Race engines can be operated above an idle. Race Engines may only be run during the following times: 9 am – 6 pm daily

Pets:

- No Pets allowed at Lime Rock Park
- Competitors and the public will be turned away if pets are found in cars or motor homes.

Camping:

- Available to competitors at no charge.
- Campground closes Monday May 28th at 7:00 p.m.

ATV's, bicycles:

- ATVs allowed in the paddock for competitors
- ATVs not allowed on the midway, campground or on the track
